power to the people

The aim of the NaSTA exec is to aid transition periods between host stations and increase continuity within NaSTA.

As such the exec will be treated as a station within NaSTA, and will have as much voting rights as any other affiliated member of NaSTA.

This means the exec have no 'additional powers' over the association and are there to guide it.

As laid out in the constitution when issues come to a vote the complete exec will have one vote, just as each station has.

electing the first bunch

Once the constitution and exec plans have been accepted nominations for the five exec positions will be opened online at: <http://www.nasta.tv/exec>

To nominate yourself you must fill in the online form, including your 500 word (maximum) manifesto. You will need to upload your 30 second video to the FTP site as detailed a little later.

Only once we get all of these will we send you an email confirming your nomination.

From this point on all correspondence will be dealt with by the returning officer, the SUSU.TV station manager, Jeni.

Once nominations have closed there will be a one week period where the nominees will be displayed online for all to see.

Voting will commence after this period, with one voting right for each affiliated station. We've built a secure online single transferrable voting system which will require each station to log in using individual passwords that will be sent to you.

being a good host

Since discussions at the AGM it was felt necessary to add a 'host exec' to the position list. It is hoped this position will aid communication between the exec and the host station.

This position will be elected within the host station and ratified at the AGM. The exec place should not be held by the host station manager. The position will change each year, with the host station.
